- Discover the historic and elegant baroque city of Prague while meandering through the narrow streets of Old Town on a morning walking tour.
- Attend noontime service at the Frauenkirche, Our Lady Lutheran Church, before traveling towards Erfurt for a reflective visit to the former concentration camp, Buchenwald, now a memorial and museum. Among the quarter million prisoners was Lutheran theologian Dietrich Bonhoeffer.
- Visit the Museum at Bernauer Strasse, where a church was formerly located in the "no-man's-land" between East and West Berlin.
- Experience a walking tour of Wittenberg, exploring the town where Martin Luther lived and taught for 36 years including visits to Castle Church, the Luther House and the Melancthon House Museum.
- Learn about the culture and people which gave rise to a tradition of reformers of church, education, and government.
