For 31 years, Rev Gary Cockrell served as the Executive Director of FLBC, and in the 12 years I have been the Director, Gary has been an amazing help to me. He has done everything from helping with a shoreline remediation, walking the land to show me the boundaries, introducing me to the amazing "family" of FLBC, helping with grants, and serving while I was on my eight-week sabbatical. When I started at FLBC, Sept 2011, I asked Gary if he would write the history of the camp.

Gary, has now been part of the camp's ministry for over $\frac{1}{2}$ the life of the camp (43 years)! Gary has been amazing: writing, organizing files, going through photos and copious documents to put the history of FLBC together. He is compiling a keepsake that will be a blessing for FLBC forever.

I had the joy of interviewing Gary and Carol in their home, January 11, 2023. We give thanks and praise to God for Gary, and his wife Carol and their 4 boys, who helped grow and impact FLBC! Join Gary this summer at our June 30–July 2, 80th Celebration, and hear more stories about FLBC. **THANK YOU, GARY!**

What have you discovered working on FLBC's history?

I discovered the deep care that Montana Lutherans had for their youth and how intrepid they were in finding and building a spiritual place for them. The financial gifts given in the middle of WWII from congregations and individuals were remarkable! Giving \$15, \$25, and \$50 to help the camp was like giving \$255, \$425, and \$850 in 2023 dollars. Reading old documents, I could feel the Holy Spirit working through donors, congregations and volunteers who found one of the most spectacular places on Flathead Lake and with God's help created a sacred place there. Then in hundreds of pages of history, I saw the belief that donors and churches had in this place. I witnessed 80 years of their continued support and giving to this ministry!

What were your greatest joys as Executive Director through the years?

Working with amazing donors and congregations across Montana who believed in FLBC's ministry and graciously supported it was a strengthening joy to me through the years. It was a joy working with the outstanding year-round staff over the years. And of course, it was a joy seeing the campers and adults have a meaningful, spiritual experience at camp. Each year it was a joy watching the summer staff grow in their faith and skills, taking on responsibility and challenges, learning what ministry in a community was about and then with the Holy Spirit doing that ministry.

Humble Gary would never share his amazing accomplishments at camp... but thanks to Gary's endless hours of work, we have the permits in the National Forest for our backpacking, rafting, and rock-climbing trips. Gary also started the sailing program on Flathead Lake.

What were your greatest challenges?

The greatest challenge of course was always safety. Twenty-four hours a day – safety! Creating and carrying out meaningful programs was always a challenge. There was the constant challenge of maintaining and updating the buildings – as well as

upgrading the infrastructure to benefit everyone and meet government regulations. Finances were continually challenging. Thankfully, gracious donors always enabled ministry to happen!

You shared that you and Carol have included FLBC in your estate.

Yes, we have FLBC in our estate plan. The camp's ministry has had an impact on the lives of thousands of young campers and adults over 80 years. It has also been a blessing to Carol and me and our four sons. By giving a gift from our estate we hope that this ministry will continue to be impactful. So, I encourage you, the reader, to put FLBC in your will.

Besides the financial help, a charitable gift from your estate teaches your family about stewardship. It also says a great deal about you and what you value and your vision for ministry beyond your life.

What are your hopes and dreams for FLBC?

That this special place will always be a Christian ministry! It is a gift from God, a sacred place. As

congregational membership shrinks today and congregations have fewer youth and our society becomes less Christian, FLBC's ministry will become even more important. The camp may even have to change its operational name to Flathead Lutheran Outdoor Ministries or Flathead Lake Christian Ministries or another name that spreads a wider net under which the Gospel is shared.

In 1983, I sat in a coffee shop in Billings and talked with Rev. Ocee Johnson, who was the pastor in Conrad, MT in 1943 and involved with starting the camp. I will never forget this statement from him:

"Back then we just tried to find and build a place for our young people to have a week of Bible camp each summer. We could not have imagined that it would grow into what it is today with so many programs as well as being year-round."

Thank you Ocee! And with that 'look back' from Pastor Johnson, we continue to pray for the Holy Spirit's guidance today and into the future for Christian ministry in this holy place.

Many things are always in the works at camp, to make camp safer, more accessible, and more FUN!!!

Did you know that NO user fees are used for capitol improvements? Improvements are made through designated gifts!

Some items recently completed, or ALMOST complete!

- New swim dock with accessible chair lift From the Holy Ground Phase 1 appeal
- Cold water sinks in cabins 9-14 From the Holy Ground Phase 1 appeal
- Sauna (used to be Cabin #1!) This was approved by the board, in 1980... sometimes things take a while to get done!
- An additional kiln donated!
- Upgrade transformer to more power, so we can add another kiln From Holy Ground Phase 1 appeal
- Internet updates including STARLINK Thanks to the MJ Murdock Charitable Trust
- Water Trampoline donated, and will be installed for this summer
- New roofs on 6 cabins (replaced due to hail damage)

Not started, but working on!

- Outdoor chapel benches these were so rotted, we have not been able to use for some time. For FLBC's 80th birthday, if you would like to donate a bench, the cost is \$750 and it will be engraved with your name, a memorial, church name, Bible verse, or whatever you would like!!
- Amphitheatre re-model The remodeled theatre will have an aisle down the middle for easier access
- Cabins Bear Paw and Aeneas remodeled removing child size beds and going to twin beds!
- Shalom Home multi use facility for staff housing or small retreat group
- An Eco burial area for bio degradable urns Families' names would be put on a plaque, in a walk-through meditative area.

With our strategic plan adopted in 2022, the master planning team is hard at work! Some of the ideas being explored include:

- Laundry facility at camp, for staff and guest linens
- A 12–14 room building for housing retreat guests, family campers, volunteers, and staff
- Office building on site (currently Admin office at FLBC in Kalispell, with program office at camp)
- Shepherd's Rest this has been in the plan for decades! A place for church leaders to 'come away' to rest, recharge, have sabbatical time, and/or volunteer
- More privacy in cabins
- Buying more property as a buffer to protect the camps 'wilderness' feel
- Making trails more accessible to the beach and campfire area

Musings from Margie

Margie Fiedler, Executive Director

I am often asked... "Why are kids so different these days?" There appears to be many factors, but many social and child psychologists believe smartphone and social media play a central role. According to psychologist Jonathan Haidt, when he reported to a



Senate subcommittee, he shared "online life transformed childhood activity, attention, social relationships, and consciousness." The US Surgeon General, Vivek Murthy wrote in a 2021 report, that "youth feel worse about themselves, using social media." Joseph Allen, a Clinical psychologist who specializes in adolescent social development, said, "social media does not give kids what they need. With phone and video games beckoning them 24/7 with features engineered to be addictive... youth spend less time outside playing, exercising, and attending religious and other community activities, all which boost their mood."

With all the challenges so real, the fact is that camp has never been more needed or important. According to the American Camping Association, "As a society we are just beginning to understand the long-term effects of extended isolation on children and teens. Camp is a safe place to grow in socio-emotional skill and build confidence. Camp connects young people to the environment, to skills, to fun to community, and an opportunity to grow in faith."

A study conducted by psychologists Ruth Ann Atchely and David L. Strayer found that creative problem solving can be drastically improved by both disconnecting from technology and reconnecting with nature. Improving problem solving tasks by 50%! Maybe that is why our campers love solving issues on the low ropes course and the escape room! And of course, every activity we have campers participate in are all for the purpose of faith development and personal and community growth.

Increasing costs and a changing economy make camp this summer a tough choice for families at a time when the educational benefits of camp are more important than ever. I am so thankful that FLBC is committed to making a summer at camp more feasible for young adults by drastically increasing

salary and bonuses. FLBC is also committed to NEVER turning away children/families because of an inability to pay. For this reason, we are focusing on asking churches, individuals, organizations, and businesses to "Adopt A Staff person." Any amount helps! \$5,000 covers salary; \$15,000 covers the cost of having a staff member, but any amount helps! For a gift of \$3,600 or more, you will be connected with a staff member, (if you want to be!) to communicate with them, and get to know them better. Camperships of ANY size help send a child to camp! From \$10.00 to \$890 (our cost per camper) and anything in-between or above! FLBC has NEVER charged anyone what it costs for camp. Each person is subsidized.

So, join us with your prayers for an awesome 80th year of ministry! Encourage young adults to work at FLBC this summer, and help send a child to camp! Yes, help them unplug for a week, to grow emotionally and spiritually.

Building the Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp Endowment Funds

In 2023, Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp (FLBC) will celebrate its 80th anniversary and implement an expanded vision based on its recently-updated Strategic Plan. One of the goals is to build-up the General Endowment Fund to help sustain FLBC for years to come.

Plans have been approved by the FLBC leadership staff and Board to increase the compensation for the Summer 2023 staff. We are working to recruit cream-of-the-crop summer counselors and staff, many of whom are between the ages of 18 and 24. Each summer staff member will receive \$400 per week plus room and board. If a staff member is willing and available to serve for the full summer (11 weeks) and signs on by March 31, their compensation (including bonuses) will move to \$5,000 plus.

If you are open to considering a \$125,000 pledge over the next five years designated for the FLBC Endowment, your gift will generate funds to support a summer staff position every year going forward. The Endowment Fund is invested for long-term growth and the Finance and Endowment Committees have approved a distribution of approximately 4% annually. [4% of \$125,000 = \$5,000.]

For those individuals, families and churches who make gifts of \$125,000 or more for the Endowment Fund, it is possible to name the fund in honor of or in memory of a family, friend or faith community as well as designating its purpose to support summer staff, year round staff, camp programs, current operating needs, camperships, capital projects (new and maintenance) and environmental improvements.

Please contact us to learn about donor-advantageous ways to make high-impact gifts that will bring joy to each donor as well as contributing to the future of FLBC. We are prepared to help individuals and families consider a multi-year pledge for the FLBC Endowment Fund and/or to plan legacy gifts to help ensure the future of Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp.
