

Moving Forward On Faith on the Strategic & Master Plan

The FLBC board of directors adopted the Strategic plan for FLBC in October 2022. Since then, groups have been working to fulfill the plan. The Master planning committee, under the direction of Wade Bitz, have put a plan together that will help the camp be more accessible, be able to accommodate more guest housing for couples, and families, and make the camp more welcoming to all. At the January 2024 board meeting the board voted to move forward with a feasibility study to 'test the waters' of how people feel about the plan. FLBC hired GSB, a well-known firm who led let the last capital campaign "Firm Foundations." God has entrusted this ministry this land to us, and we as caretakers and stewards of this Holy Ground, are excited to move forward in faith with the plan. 

There is a reason that our moments of True Fun stand out in our memories; True Fun makes us feel alive."

The word "fun "doesn't appear in the Bible, but the word "joy" shows up 269 times. One of the fruits of the Spirit is JOY. Jesus said, "I have said these things to you so that my JOY may be in you and that your JOY may be complete." ~ John 15:11.

Whether it's summer camp, family camp, or retreat time with your congregation, or friends, fun is definitely on the agenda. So, let's go have some FUN! Celebrating God's love! Abundant Blessings Bring Transformational Gifts

2023 marked the 80th anniversary of Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp (FLBC).

Donors, churches, families and friends, staff (summer and year-round) and campers celebrated with joy and generosity. Looking forward, we encourage you to join us in sharing our abundant gifts of time, talent and treasures to bless and help support the year round and summer staff as well as programs, capital projects, buildings and grounds, maintenance and campers. Gifts given generously with unconditional love are transformational. We give thanks for your blessings!

In 2024, thank you for renewing and increasing your charitable gift plans for FLBC. In addition to making gifts of cash, you may want to consider other giving options with tax advantages. We are prepared to assist you in establishing endowment fund gift plans, sharing appreciated securities, making charitable gifts from retirement accounts, sharing gifts from donor advised funds (DAF's) and including FLBC in your Will and estate plans. If you would like to designate FLBC as a percentage recipient of your life insurance, individual retirement account (IRA), or your real estate (land and/ or house), we will be happy to help you.

One of our key fundraising goals is to assist donors in establishing named endowment funds with individual gifts and pledges of \$125,000 or more to provide support for our summer and year-round staff. Once in place, a \$125,000 endowment fund will generate approximately 4% annually to support the FLBC staff. Additional earnings and growth in the endowment funds over the years will continue to expand the benefits. These named endowment funds can be given over one to five years; and, they will bless and benefit FLBC in perpetuity.

There are other planned giving options available to produce supplemental life income and provide ultimate support for FLBC. Income-producing charitable trusts can be established with initial gifts of \$100,000 or more. Charitable gift annuities (CGA's) can be funded with \$10,000 or more to provide fixed supplemental life income for one or two lives of beneficiaries with the charitable remainder interest for FLBC. All the rates for newly-funded CGA's increased significantly on January 1, 2024.

This summer and fall, my husband (Doug Scott) will join me in leading charitable planned giving seminars at FLBC and in several churches in Helena, Missoula and Hamilton, Montana. Doug and I have extensive vocational backgrounds in philanthropy and we value assisting donors in charitable giving to support Christian missions.
