After much study, surveys, feasibility studies, strategic plan finalized for the years 2022–2027 & the master plan coming out of the strategic plan, the board is working on many things:

- Staff Retention
- Staff Scholarship Endowment
- Program Review/Evaluation

The prominent Themes & Goals of the Master Plan:

- · Welcoming and Wayfinding
- Accessible to All
 - Financially
 - Physically
 - Emotionally
- Create community while supporting privacy and diversity of guest needs
- Support the staff to enhance recruitment and retention
- Celebrate the site context and create a sense of awe, wonder and adventure
- Develop in a sustainable and earth-friendly manner

The board voted at its January 2025 meeting to launch the 1^{st} phase of the Holy Ground capital campaign, with the theme "**Hospitality**" 'And there were those who welcomed angels unaware' \sim Hebrews 13:1

The campaign goals for Phase 1 include (costs are estimates):

- Work to make camp more accessible connecting pathways
- Building a new guest/volunteer housing unit
- Improving bathrooms (#1 complaint by campers)
- Infrastructure—additional RV sites, relocating nature center; utility structure for next phases

\$1M—Growing the endowment (3 parts to our endowment):

- 1. General endowment (for Facilities & Programs)
- 2. Campership endowment
- 3. Staff leadership endowment.

\$3.4-3.7M = Total Phase #1 Campaign

Outright gifts/pledges (3–5 years) can be designated to this phase or to future phases/projects.





QCDs allow individuals age $70\frac{1}{2}$ or older to make tax-free contributions up to \$108,000 in 2025 directly from their IRAs to one or more eligible charities. Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp (FLBC) is an amazing transformational blessing and an eligible charitable organization, Internal Revenue Code 501(c)(3). QCDs are especially appealing to baby boomers managing their required minimum distributions (RMDs). Age 73 is currently the age for RMDs from IRAs.

DAFs are projected this year to outpace overall philanthropy in growth, as more donors turn to them for their flexibility and tax advantages.



What are the tax benefits of a donor-advised fund? These donations provide two tax benefits:

- Become eligible for an income tax deduction of the full fair-market value of the asset, up to 30% of your adjusted gross income.
- Potentially eliminate and maximize capital gains tax on long-term appreciated assets, as long as they've been held for more than a year.

If you regularly give to multiple nonprofit charities – your alma mater, your house of worship or other favorite charities like FLBC — you might benefit from streamlining your giving through a Donor-Advised Fund.
