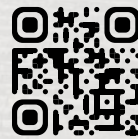

J-Term

On December 17th, as a windstorm with gusts over 100 miles per hour tore through the valley, the FLBC retreat phone rang even as power and communications were breaking down. It was a displaced professor from Minneapolis. Holden Village, a nearby ECLA Retreat Center, had closed due to severe damage from flooding. Augsburg, Luther, and Augustana Colleges all needed a place to spend their January term, and they needed it within three weeks. Our incredible FLBC team began preparing a temporary home for approximately 45 students and their professors. Beds made, meals planned, spaces opened all in preparation to minister to a group we did not realize would transform us, too.

Not unlike the storm, these remarkable humans brought a fresh wind of life with them. They filled our spaces with joy, laughter, song, and friendship. We had them for almost a month, and it wasn't long enough.

Pr. Jason Executive Director, describes our work as partnering with creation in ministry. This resonates with me. I, too, am passionate about mutuality—the reciprocity of all things. As we welcomed them, we realized their purpose aligned deeply with our own. These professors and their students were there to study and contemplate vocation, and the reciprocity of our place in creation. They came to one of the most undeniably beautiful places to ponder creation and our relationship to it at FLBC. They shared their curriculum with us (I highly recommend one of the assigned readings, *Church of the Wild* by Victoria Looz), and we shared our vocational stories with them.

Our team offered a daily rhythm of optional spiritual practices (yoga, lectio and visio divina, silence and solitude, spiritual walks and runs, polar plunges, and prayer labyrinth) each morning. Our Wilderness Director, Justin, prepared ski and snowshoe outings and organized trips to the local biology station, the bison range, and other outdoor experiences to study the local ecology and the justice issues surrounding it. Jess, Linda, Chris, and Dennis provided delicious meals that became the backdrop for meaningful conversation as students processed what they were learning and how they were growing.

Meanwhile, the students and professors blessed FLBC through generous acts of service. We bonded in the kitchen over dishes, and they cleaned cabins. These ordinary acts became sacred ground for relationship. Our Rock Room is looking as spiffy as ever, thanks to their care and attention. And of course, we solidified our friendships as Karen, Elizabeth, and Riley led afternoon and evening fellowship activities like pottery, karaoke, games, dance parties, and meaningful conversation around the campfire.

I've heard it said that as image bearers, every time we get to know another person, we come to know another facet of God. I believe this is true, and while we expected a quiet month of recovery in January, the unexpected arrival of these students from Iowa, Illinois, and Minnesota blessed us beyond measure. We at FLBC have come to know more about our Creator through the love and friendship of our staff and teammates, as well as these beloved students and faculty. We encountered Christ in one another, and we will carry that with us long after January has passed.
